Terms of the Contract:

1. The engagement of Assistant Professor is purely temporary/short-term and will be filled on a contractual basis for a period of 11 months only.
2. The engagement of Assistant Professors will be on a contractual basis for a period of 11 months or until regular appointments are made, whichever earlier with fixed monthly emoluments of ₹ 57,700/- for candidates possessing a Ph.D./NET qualification and ₹ 40,000/- for candidates possessing a Master's degree only.
3. In the event of selection, the candidate shall be required to **report for duty within 15 days** from the date of issue of the engagement order. Failure to do so shall result in automatic cancellation of the selection, and the position may be offered to another eligible candidate. The place of posting shall be in the concerned Faculty/Department or any other place as directed by the competent authority.
4. Depending upon the requirements of the University, the incumbent may be required to remain on duty beyond the prescribed working hours or at such other times as may be necessary.
5. In addition to teaching duties, all selected candidates shall be required to perform such other academic and administrative duties as may be assigned by the competent authority from time to time, including **examination and evaluation of answer books, research activities, cultural and sports activities**, and any other University assignment as per institutional requirements, even beyond normal working hours, whenever necessary.
6. The engagement shall be for the period specified in the advertisement. However, if **the work and conduct of the incumbent are found unsatisfactory**, his/her services may be terminated at any time, after giving show cause notice and the said terminated incumbent shall have no claim whatsoever except to any unpaid remuneration for the period he had actually worked. 10. A selected candidate wishing to leave the engagement shall be required to give **one month's advance notice**. In the absence of such notice, the candidate shall be required to **surrender one month's remuneration in lieu of the notice period**. Resignation shall ordinarily be accepted only for joining another **permanent job**. The candidate shall not be permitted to pursue/join any higher degree or higher education programme during the period of engagement.
11. In case of cancelling of engagement due to any reason, the next incumbent will be on merit basis.
12. The engagement may be renewed, subject to satisfactory performance at the discretion of the competent authority and the incumbent. **A break of 15 days** shall be given between two consecutive years of engagement or during the semester break, as applicable. The selected candidate shall have **no right whatsoever to claim regularization, permanent appointment or absorption** in CSAUAT, Kanpur.
13.
